<sup>2</sup> “Ghostwriting” occurs when someone has made a significant contribution to the publication without disclosing his participation as one of the authors or without mentioning his role in the acknowledgments included in the publication.

<sup>3</sup> “Guest authorship” (“honorary authorship”) occurs when the author's participation is negligible or did not take place at all, and yet he is the author or co-author of the publication.

<sup>4</sup> “Ghostwriting” and “guest authorship” are a manifestation of scientific misconduct, about which the Editorial Board will notify the institution, they employ the author, a relevant scientific society and scientific editors' associations.
